# VILLAGE OF COXSACKIE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES REGULAR MEETING APRIL 11, 2017

## APPLICATION FOR BUILDING RESTORATION FROM PARKVIEW PROPERTIES, LLC

A motion was made by Diane Fausel and seconded by Betty Cure to approve the application for restoration of the former McQuade building, 2 Mansion Street, currently owned by Parkview Properties, LLC (Aaron Flach, principal). The application included replacement of the following:

The slate roof to be replaced with architectural shingles in either of two colors:

Williamsburg Slate or Midnight Blush.

The existing gutters will be replaced with copper gutters.

The windows to be replaced with Marvin windows, matching the current 6 over 6 panes with aluminum clad exteriors and wood interiors.

The building will be painted to match the original colors- white with black and grey trim.

The doors and porch will be restored to their original design.

The motion was carried.

### **VILLAGE CEMETERY**
