 - 2. Call to Order, Minutes:** The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm by Acting Chairperson Bob Van Valkenburg. The minutes from our regular meeting on August 15, 2019 were approved in a motion made by Stacey Smith and seconded by Rodney Levine. Motion carried.

 - D. **Guest** – Richard Golden attended our meeting. He is a member of the Greene County Planning Board (they meet the 3rd Wednesday of every month) and wanted to meet with us and to introduce himself as Coxsackie's representative to the County Board. Richard spoke of the County's initiative to provide better coordination among the County and the local Village and Town Planning Boards. We discussed the referral (General Municipal Law Section 239) that needs to be made by local Planning Boards when a proposed project is sited within 500 feet of intra municipal boundaries (i.e. a county or state road or boundary lines, town vs. village boundary lines, etc.). Richard also confirmed that the correspondence the Planning Board had received regarding our Agricultural District needed no further action other than the public posting of the notice, which Bob had already done.
 - E. No other business was brought before the Board so the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM in a motion made by Stacey Smith and seconded by Rodney Levine. Motion carried.
 - F. Our next regular meeting is scheduled for October 17, 2019.
