**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SECTION 145-47 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF
COXSACKIE**

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Board of the Village of Coxsackie as follows:

Section 1. Title of Local Law.

This Local Law shall be entitled “A Local Law to Amend Section 145-47 of the Village Code of the Village of Coxsackie.”

Section 2. Authorization.

This local law is enacted pursuant to the authorization established in the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law section 20 to amend the Village Code of the Village of Coxsackie.

Section 3. Amendments.

Section 145-47 of the Village Code of the Village of Coxsackie is hereby as follows:

In accordance with the provisions of § 145-17, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon the following streets or parts of streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Ely Street	Both	From the corner of Ely Street and New Street to the top of Ely Street at the Village line
Ely Street	East	From lower New Street south to the drainageway under Ely Street
Mansion Street	South	From Bailey Street to a point 75 feet west thereof
Mansion Street	South	Washington Avenue to a point 200 feet west thereof

Mansion Street	South	From intersection with Freleigh Place Extension to 50 Mansion Street
New Street	North	From intersection with Ely Street to intersection with South River Street
South River Street	East	From lower New Street north to Pantaleo Boulevard
South River Street	West	From lower New Street to Reed Street
South River Street	Both	From 60 South River Street to intersection with Reed Street
Washington Avenue	West	From Mansion Street to a point 200 feet south thereof

Section 4. Supersession.

Pursuant to the powers granted by the Municipal Home Rule, this Local Law supersedes all provisions of the Village Code herein addressed, in so far as such statutes are inconsistent with this Law and any other laws or regulations of the Village of Coxsackie are superseded to the extent necessary to give this Local Law full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
