

What is Community Choice Aggregation?

The NYS Public Service Commission enabled Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) Opt-Out programs, which offer residential and small commercial customers an opportunity to receive more attractive energy supply terms through the bargaining power that aggregation provides.



What is a CCA Administrator?

The CCA Administrator is a company, non-profit, or local government that has been authorized by the Public Service Commission to administer a CCA program in New York State. The CCA Administrator is responsible for working with participating municipalities to design and implement a CCA program consistent with the goals of the municipality and its constituents and in compliance with CCA program requirements. The CCA Administrator solicits bids, awards a supply contract, and performs the necessary program outreach and education to ensure residents are well educated about the Program. For those customers who do not opt out of the Program, the CCA Administrator works with your utility to ensure proper enrollment.



What Role Does My Municipality Play?

The municipality is the primary party responsible for meeting the requirements established by the Public Service Commission. First, to enable CCA in your municipality, a Local Law must be passed that allows for opt-out enrollment for eligible residential and small commercial accounts. The municipality would then either administer the CCA Program themselves, or select a CCA Administrator to perform the necessary CCA program requirements.

Community Choice Aggregation | CCA | in New York

CCA enables a Municipality to aggregate the electric and natural gas loads of their residents and small businesses to gain greater buying power.

Benefits of a CCA:

- ✓ Leverage community population
- ✓ Fixed price for residents and small businesses
- ✓ Same utility bill
- ✓ Same utility service
- ✓ Community Solar options
- ✓ **Natural gas is priority based on potential savings**

Eligible Accounts

- SC1 Residential
- SC2 Small Commercial

Ineligible Accounts

- Blocked
- EAP - Energy Assistance
- Accounts on an ESCO (Supplier) contract
- Accounts that previously opted out; must opt into Program

How will it impact your energy bill?

- Two Components: Your bill has two major cost components
 - **Supply**
 - **Delivery**
- Supply: CCA changes only the Supply component of bill
- Delivery: This component will not change
- **No change in utility service**

Cossackie Program Update

- Current Cossackie Electricity Program expired December 2024
- Return to Utility for 3 months
- Plans to re-launch in March 2025
- Administrator Agreement with Good Energy has been executed
- Outreach and milestone schedule to be created and submitted to the DPS of NY
- RFP for ESCO award - Constellation Energy (incumbent supplier)

How to Enroll?

- ✓ No need to sign up, automatic enrollment
- ✓ Opt-out letter
- ✓ 30 Days to opt out
- ✓ Same Utility Bill
- ✓ Opt in or opt out at anytime without additional cost

How to Opt Out

- ✓ Receive your Opt-Out letter
- ✓ 30 days to opt out prior to the first meter read of the Program
- ✓ Call in number: (833) 475-5228
- ✓ Three methods to opt out
