Questions about your sewer services, including how to disconnect a sump pump or roof leader from the sanitary sewer system, can be addressed with the Village reach out to the

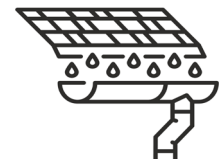

3 Easy Things You Can Do to Help



- 3. DON'T FLUSH WIPES** (even if they are labeled as flushable or septic safe), diapers, wrappers, feminine products, etc.



- 2. MAKE SURE YOUR ROOF LEADERS and SUMP PUMP NOT CONNECTED TO THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM**

- 1. DON'T DUMP OILS DOWN THE DRAIN**
